President's Message

Please join us for the Annual Meeting Teleconference on Saturday October 4th at 2pm Eastern. This one time change from our usual Sunday calls is to coincide with Lesotho's Independence Day. The phone number and instructions are listed elsewhere in the paper version of this Annual Report mailed to the membership. If you are not a member but would like to participate, just contact any Board Member for information. Also, please vote for Board of Directors candidates and two By-Laws proposed changes. Voting may be done by paper ballot (mailed to members in this packet) or by the VOTE link, in the upper right corner of the web site, <http://friendsoflesotho.org> Candidate statements and a description of the By-Laws proposals may be found on the ballots.

2008 has been a productive year. The Fundraising Committee has come up with numerous items, including general logo-type merchandise at <http://www.cafepress.com/lesotho> , an affiliation with Amazon.com, and most recently an arrangement with the Children's Art Organization of Lesotho to market bookmarks and luggage tags. Look for the 2009 Friends of Lesotho calendar on CaféPress later this fall. Merchandise sales help promote an awareness of Lesotho. However, the majority of our funds still come from individual donations. Individual contributions have been strong. Thanks to all who have contributed, and especially to the Taipei American School for their major donation again this year.

During 2008 we started accepting credit cards for dues payments and contributions, and saw a rise in the membership renewal rate. We are continuing to develop ties with the Friends of Lesotho NGO in Maseru and have sent \$8,500 to Phachela Primary School near Mafeteng for classroom construction. Other projects receiving funding are listed in the Treasurer's report. With almost half the year left, more distributions to Lesotho projects and programs will be made in next few months, in consultation with the VAC and TAP.

On the Board itself, we continue to put primary responsibility for activities at the committee level, keeping Board meetings at a high level. Committees comprised of both Board and non-Board members conduct the business of the organization. Sadly though, we recently lost two of our Board members. Mary Beth Kwenda and Paula Fitzpatrick have informed me that they will not be able to continue with us. I would like to wish both Mary Beth and Paula well, and thank them for their contributions.

This is my last letter as President. After the Annual Meeting I will be retiring from the Board and turning things over to a new President. The Board elects Officers from its own members at the November Board meeting. I will continue to attend the meetings however, and provide support on the web site and database.

Ella Kwisnek will also be retiring at the end of her term. Ella has served as Secretary for the past four years and done a tremendous job. Thank you for your service, Ella!

For 2009, I'm looking forward to finalizing our relationship with Friends of Lesotho NGO. Guided by TAP and VAC members, they are now the primary mechanism for distributing our funds in Lesotho and it will be important to make sure the arrangement is solid and long-lasting. As always, recruiting more help on the Board and Committees will be necessary for long-term health of the organization. As I write this in mid-August, I do not yet know how many Board candidates we'll have, but please consider participating in any way you can, regardless of the formal election schedule.

Committee Reports

Donations and Distributions Committee has general responsibility for distributing charitable donations on behalf of Friends of Lesotho.

- Helped establish a Non-Governmental Agency in Lesotho that oversees and distributes FOL donations on behalf of the Volunteer Advisory Committee (VAC) and the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP). This was necessary because Peace Corps policies now prohibit direct donations to Peace Corps and its Volunteers.
- Oversaw the donation of funds to VAC and TAP.

- Funded a project of the African Libraries Project to help communities better use local libraries built with the assistance of the African Libraries Project. FOL funds support PCVs involved with this project.
- Facilitated the collection and transfer of funds for the Village Hope Project. This project supports children affected by the HIV/AIDS crisis in Lesotho.

- Donated funds to support a borehole project in Qacha's Nek.
- Facilitated the collection and transfer of funds to a PCV sponsored project to build a classroom for Pacheha Primary School.
- Made a donation to the Pacheha Primary School project.
- Worked to standardize the application procedure for people requesting FOL assistance.
- Assisted with the transfer of funds to the Lesotho Child Counseling Unit (LCCU).

Membership Committee recruits new members, responds to inquiries from members and potential members, creates promotional materials, and maintains a membership database.
